Donnelly Rural Fire Protection District is accepting applications for a Full Time FF. This individual will be assigned to shift on a 48/96 hour rotation.

District Profile

DRFPD has a fire response area of 156 square miles and an EMS response of 170 square miles. Our department consists of 10 full time career staff, 1 part time staff, and 30 members. We operate a Paramedic level ambulance service with occasional interfacility transfers. Our 2016 call volume was 340 runs with 80% related to EMS. We respond to structure and wildland fires, rescue operations and are available for incident resource orders on large incidents.

Donnelly is a mountain town in the heart of Idaho, nestling itself between two ski resorts, two lakes and several opportunities for outdoor recreation. With miles of hiking, biking, snowmobiling, skiing, and snowshoeing trails, Donnelly lends itself to the outdoor enthusiasts who love the small town lifestyle.

Required Qualifications

- Two (2) years prior experience as a volunteer/fulltime Firefighter
- Firefighter I certified In-House/State certification or higher
- Ability to obtain EMT certification within one year of hire date
- Ability to obtain BLS Instructor AHA within one year of hire date
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Able to pass background investigation and drug screening
- Possession of a valid Idaho Class D Driver's license or able to obtain within one month of hire date

Application Process
